Full Job Description:

The Mental health Clinician provides professional therapeutic services to persons with mental illness and/or addictive disease.

Provides service coordination for an assigned group of clients; Arranges appointment schedule at optimal intervals to maximize use of work time. Conducts face-to-face (or by tele-health)comprehensive assessment of psychiatric history to identify problems and service needs.

As a clinician one must be able to assess, diagnose, and treat mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders. Assist individuals to deal with problems ranging from short-term personal issues to severe, chronic conditions. This will be done under the supervision of the Clinical Director.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides individual, family or group therapeutic counseling and/or educational and skill development sessions as indicated in the service plan.
- 2. Monitors patients progress and compliance with the service plan.
- 3. Writes timely progress notes that relate directly to the treatment outcomes described in the service plan.
- 4. Assembles, analyzes, and interprets new/updated information about the consumer to

reassess treatment needs.

- 5. Identifies unmet needs, reviews available resources, and modifies the treatment plan as indicated.
- 6. Provides only those consumer services that are authorized in the service plan.
- 7. Establish, document, and implement treatment plans; attend the Bi-weekly organizational staff meetings and treatment planning meetings.
- 8. Clinical skill and experience to assess, plan, develop, coordinate, and provide treatment, rehabilitation, and support services to program clients with severe and persistent mental illnesses.
- 9. Participates in providing treatment and dual diagnosis services.
- 10. Maintains confidentiality and security of administered tests and test results, in accordance with ethical standards and HIPAA.
- 11. Communicates with patient and other necessary involved parties to prepare patients for testing, to explain testing procedures and testing purpose or purposes.
- 12. Ensures comfort of the patient.
- 13. Maintains necessary patient records and inventory of administered tests.
- 14. Create treatment plans and provide treatment under supervision of a fully licensed Masters Level Clinician.
- 15. Adheres to all standards of practice outlined by the APA, NASW Code of Ethics, State Licensing Board, and other professionally relevant psychological bodies under the direction of the Clinical Director.
- 16. The Clinician functions as a multidisciplinary team member providing direct clinical services and interventions to patients, families, and significant others affected by a mental health and/or substance abuse disorder through professionally approved and appropriate means and methods.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must have Masters (MSW) in social work, MA in Psychology or other psychology field with related coursework in tests and measurements, intellectual and personality testing, and cognitive or neuropsychological testing.
- 2. Along with an MSW or MA you must also be licensed by the State of Georgia, California, Massachusetts or the State that you reside in.
- 3. Must have professional liability insurance. In order for an application to be reviewed you must have experience in performing biopsychosocial assessments assessments. You must also have experience providing treatment to individuals with mental health related disorders.
- 5. The pay range for this position is based upon experience. Based upon experience and licensure this may be negotiable.
